SMOKE FREE FACILITIES

Background

The Division has a responsibility to promote the health and welfare of staff and students and to act as a positive role model for students, therefore it requires all Division school facilities and sites to be smoke free environments.

Procedures

- 1. The Tobacco, Smoking and Vaping Reduction Act bans smoking/vaping in all public places and workplaces including work vehicles.
- 2. Smoking/vaping may occur on Division property outside of the facility after school hours in a clearly signed designated area, prohibited to minors, provided the area is kept tidy and clean.
- 3. The Division prohibits smoking/vaping within five (5) metres of a doorway, window or intake of a public place or workplace.
- 4. With the prior approval of the Principal, the use of tobacco is permitted as part of religious/ceremonial events.
- 5. Smoking/vaping on Division property by students/minors is strictly prohibited and may be subject to disciplinary action.
