PATRIOTIC EXERCISES

Background

The Division plays a role in nurturing students' pride in being a Canadian citizen.

Procedures

- 1. The Principal shall ensure:
 - 1.1 That O'Canada is sung at appropriate school functions and at all assemblies.
 - 1.2 Remembrance Day is acknowledged and honoured as outlined below:
 - 1.2.1 On November 11 at least two (2) minutes of silence from 11:00 a.m. to 11:02 a.m. will be observed in a Remembrance Day ceremony or by another appropriate means.
 - 1.2.2 When Remembrance Day falls on a non-school day, procedure 1.2.1 will be complied with on the school day immediately preceding Remembrance Day.
 - 1.2.3 If a ceremony is held at the school, all students shall either attend the ceremony or remain in the school.
- 2. Parents may request to have their child(ren) opt out of patriotic exercises for cultural and/or religious beliefs. If they are opting out, students are expected to display appropriate behaviour in their alternative activities. Notice and Student Exemption Form (Form 205-1)
