## **ACTING PRINCIPALS**

## **Background**

On occasion it may be necessary to designate an Acting Principal in the absence of the Principal. Such a designation is pursuant to the provisions of the Education Act.

## **Procedures**

- 1. In the absence of the Principal beyond a period of five (5) days, the Vice-Principal shall be appointed Acting Principal and shall be paid accordingly.
- 2. If the duration of the Acting Principal appointment is or is likely to be greater than five (5) days, an interim Vice-Principal shall also be appointed.
- 3. If the Principal is absent in a school where there is no Vice-Principal, a certificated teacher on staff shall be designated as Acting Principal and shall be paid accordingly.
