

The **GRANT NOTLEY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP** was established in memory of Grant Notley who served as the Member of the Legislative Assembly for The Spirit River-Fairview constituency from 1971 to 1984.

The scholarships available through this fund are meant to assist deserving students in their pursuit of post-secondary education.

One scholarship is available annually, in the amount of \$500.00, to:

“... students attending a high school in the constituency served by Grant Notley during his years of service as an M.L.A.; to students who obtained Grade 9 in Berwyn and are currently attending high school in Grimshaw (in the Peace River School Division No. 10); and to students who completed Grade 9 at the Bonanza School, who subsequently completed Grade 12 in Dawson Creek; and to students whose parents reside within the constituency described above at the time of the student’s graduation.”

The selection of the recipients will be based on the following criteria:

1. A typewritten essay of 500 to 1,000 words, submitted with the application. The essay topic shall be “How I Hope to Contribute to Improving the Quality of Life in Alberta”;
2. Academic achievement in Social Studies and English at the 10, 20, and 30 levels. Only teacher assigned marks, verified by the principal, will be considered. For incomplete courses, teacher marks to date are to be submitted;
3. Separate from the essay, a statement of the applicant’s contribution to, and involvement in, the community and school life, together with the applicant’s intended direction of future studies. **(DO NOT INCLUDE IN THE ESSAY)**.
4. Verification of enrolment at an accredited post-secondary educational institute.

Applications, complete with the essay and transcript of marks, shall be sent by April 20<sup>th</sup> of each school year, to:
