The TOM BALDWIN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP was established by a group of individuals, through a fundraising event in the summer of 2005. The resulting endowment purpose is to fund an annual scholarship in memory of Tom Baldwin.

One scholarship is available annually through this fund, in the amount of \$1,000.00 to a student who:

- 1. Resides within the Peace River Constituency area and is a student of the following school jurisdictions:
 - Peace River School Division
 - Holy Family Catholic Regional Division No. 37
 - Northwest Francophone Education Region No. 1
 - Ft. Vermilion School Division No. 52
 - Northland School Division No. 61
- 2. Is a resident of Alberta as defined by the Alberta Student Finance Regulation;
- 3. Is a graduate of a high school located in one of the aforementioned school jurisdictions, whether in the current year or in the previous five years;
- In the opinion of his/her teachers, has pursued his/her studies with diligence and honest effort;
- 5. Is a credit to his/her home, school, and community;
- 6. Is accepted and enrolls as a full-time student at a post-secondary institution recognized by Alberta Advanced Education;
- 7. Agrees to return to Northern Alberta (as defined by the boundaries of the Northern Alberta Development Council) to work for a minimum of two years;
- 8. Applies to the Northern Alberta Development Council's (NADC) Bursary Partnership Program or similar program offered by the NADC.

The selection of the recipient will be based on the following:

- a. A typewritten essay, maximum three pages outlining;
 - > the applicant's knowledge of the career he/she decided to pursue;
 - how the chosen career supports society in Northern Alberta;
 - the applicant's commitment to Northern Alberta and his/her community through the community activities he/she has engaged in. The essay should also include information about the applicant's contribution to,
- and involvement in, his/her home, school and community; b. A letter of reference from a teacher;
- c. A transcript of marks verified by the school principal;
- d. A completed Northern Alberta Development Council Bursary Partnerships Program Student Application.
- e. Verification of enrolment at an accredited post-secondary educational institute.

Eligible Grade 12 students are required to return their completed application and related supporting documentation to the school principal by June 30th. By September 15th of the school year following the student's graduation, the school principal will send the completed application, along with the student's most current transcript of marks to:
