

Board of Trustees express gratitude for additional Provincial funding

Grimshaw, Alta. - At the August 22 regular meeting of the Peace River School Division's Board of Trustees, the board expressed a desire to issue a note of gratitude to Peace River MLA Dan Williams, Premier Danielle Smith, Minister of Education Demetrios Nicolaides, and Minister of Finance Nate Horner for the additional education funding the Division will receive for the upcoming school year.

On July 23 the Minister of Education, together with Danielle Smith announced that an additional \$215 million in funding would be provided to school divisions across the province. For the Peace River School Division, that meant an additional \$480,631 in funding has been allocated to the Base Funding, Rural Small Schools, and Services and Supports grants (Learning Services). The division plans to use this funding to hire additional educational assistants and other instructional supports for the 2024-2025 school year. The hiring for these positions will begin after the start of the new school year, once schools have determined their areas of greatest need.

Then, on August 14, Alberta Education announced the extension of the Mental Health in Schools Pilot program by investing \$6.7 million to ensure in-school mental health supports will continue during the 2024-2025 school year. For the PRSD, this equates to an additional \$176,327.25 in funding for the continuation of their Mental Health in Schools pilot project. The plan for the additional funds is to extend the contracts of the Division's current Student Support Workers from December to June.

"This is really, really exciting. By submitting a deficit budget this year, it shows that this funding was needed. I also think we were clearly heard regarding the Mental Health in Schools pilot program."
